

# ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY

## 1 Purpose

- 1.1 This section constitutes the Acceptable Use Policy referred to in EscapeNet's Service Agreements. This document describes the guidelines that EscapeNet uses in providing services to its Clients and the rules to which EscapeNet Clients must adhere in order to continue to enjoy and allow others to enjoy optimum use of EscapeNet's Services via its network and systems.

## 2 Application

- 2.1 A breach of any of the Terms and Conditions of this policy by any EscapeNet Client is strictly prohibited and may lead to the suspension or termination of the Client's service, without notice.
- 2.2 This policy is also applicable to the users and Clients of EscapeNet's permanently connected Clients.
- 2.3 A breach of the Terms and Conditions of this policy by any user or Client of EscapeNet's permanently connected Clients may lead to the suspension or termination of the permanently connected Client's service, without notice.
- 2.4 All EscapeNet Clients must take responsibility for distribution, publication and enforcement of the EscapeNet Acceptable Use Policy at their sites.

## 3 Responsible Usage

- 3.1 The End-User must take responsibility for their actions on the network and systems accessed through EscapeNet.
- 3.2 The End-User must comply with rules, regulations and acceptable usage policies that are in force for each system they access.
- 3.3 If the End-User acts recklessly or irresponsibly or their actions endanger EscapeNet's network or systems, your access may be suspended or terminated at any time, without notice.
- 3.4 EscapeNet requires you to act responsibly when consuming resources on EscapeNet's network and systems. If you unreasonably consume excess resources on EscapeNet's network and systems access may be suspended or terminated at any time, without notice.
- 3.5 EscapeNet requires you to take responsibility for maintaining the security of your EscapeNet service.
- 3.6 Protection of the security aspects of your service, like accounts and passwords, are your responsibility.
- 3.7 Usage of your service by a third party will result in you being responsible for the charges incurred.
